

RESOLUTION
R 202 - 06 / 07

ENVIRONMENTAL COURT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama approved Ordinance No. O109-04/05, amending Ordinance No. O11-00/01A, regulating Garbage and Trash Collection Services within the City of Selma ; *and*

WHEREAS, the rate of twelve (\$12.00) per month was established per residence for curbside pickup; *and*

WHEREAS, many individuals that receive curbside pickup are failing to pay their monthly fees causing their garbage accounts to be delinquent and further in violation of the ordinance; *and*

WHEREAS, per Ordinance No. O109-04/05, the City of Selma may elect to proceed in collecting any outstanding bill that is not paid within ninety (90) days from the date of the bill by suspending such service and/or proceeding to recover the delinquent amount, with interest, in municipal court or through a collection agency;

WHEREAS, the City Council has entertained implementing an Environmental Court to enforce issues related to loud noise, litter, vandalism, dilapidated houses, abandoned vehicles, untidy yards, overgrown lots, etc.; *and*


WHEREAS, the City Council of the Selma further desires that when the Environmental Court is feasible and functioning that the collection of delinquent garbage fees, ninety (90) days or more past due, shall be enforced through the same.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA THAT:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to proceed in establishing an Environmental Court to enforce issues and concerns relevant to loud noise, litter, vandalism, dilapidated houses, abandoned vehicles, untidy yards, overgrown lots, etc


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon the implementation of the Environmental Court, that violations of Ordinance No. O109-04/05 and delinquent garbage fees, ninety (90) days or more past due, shall be enforced and collected via the City of Selma's Municipal Court-Environment Court.
