AND OTHER CITY OF SELMA SITES**

WHEREAS, National Park Service under The United States Department of Interior request permission from the City of Selma to remove existing Wayside Exhibits and add new Wayside Exhibits and additional exhibits; and


WHEREAS, these exhibits will be designed to meet National Park Service standards and will be maintained by the National Park Service to meet requirements of Wayside Exhibits; and

WHEREAS, the information contained on each Wayside Exhibit will meet all National Park Service qualifications for historic authenticity; and

WHEREAS, the National Park Service exhibits on Martin Luther King, Jr. Street and additional historic site exhibits will enhance the National Voting Rights Trail experience for tourists.




